

The East Marshall Community School District will use its allotted ESSER III dollars in the following way:

Twenty percent of the total ESSER III funds will be allocated and committed to services to offset student learning loss due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Students who have experienced learning loss from the COVID-19 pandemic and those most discrepant from their peers will be provided additional services in reading and mathematics during the 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 school years. Estimated cost: \$136,108.

Improvements in air quality in all school buildings throughout the East Marshall Community School District are needed, as well as, restroom refurbishing and remodeling. The use of ESSER III dollars will contribute to a portion of the total cost for HVAC and restroom updates. The ESSER III contribution estimated cost: \$544,430.
