

PUBLIC CONDUCT ON SCHOOL PREMISES
SPECTATOR CONDUCT INITIATIVE – “CONDUCT COUNTS”

In the East Marshall Community School District, these behaviors are **NOT** acceptable:

- Disrespectful conduct, including profanity, obscene gestures or comments, offensive remarks of a sexual nature, or other actions that demean individuals or the event.

Penalty – EJECTION

- Throwing articles onto the contest area.

Penalty – EJECTION

- Entering the contest area in protest or celebration.

Penalty – EJECTION

- Physical confrontation involving contest officials, coaches/directors, contestants or spectators.

Penalty – EJECTION

- Spectator interference with the event.

Penalty – EJECTION

- Jumping up and down on the bleachers.

Penalty – Warning/EJECTION

- Use of artificial noisemakers, signs or banners.

Penalty – Warning/EJECTION

- Chants or cheers directed at opponents.

Penalty – Warning/EJECTION
