EAST MARSHALL SCHOOL REGISTRATION

2022-2023 School Year

The purpose of pre-registration is to enable school officials to prepare and adjust schedules prior to the beginning of school and to assist parents with questions regarding school programs and procedures. Registration for all grade levels may be completed on **Tuesday, August 2, 2022, at the LeGrand High School from 12:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.** If you are unable to register on this day, registration can be taken care of in the principals' offices in each respective school building.

Kindergarten students must have their physical forms presented prior to enrollment as per state law. New families in the district are urged to pre-register their children so that their school records can be forwarded to the East Marshall school system.

Student fees for the 2022-2023 school year should be paid at the time of registration. Book rent for grades K-5 is \$50.00 per semester or \$100.00 per year; grades 6-8 is \$55.00 per semester or \$110.00 per year; grades 9-12 is \$60.00 per semester or \$120.00 per year.

There will be a \$50.00 security deposit for individual laptops/iPads that will be provided to all grade levels. **The deposit only needs paid one time per student.**

Lunch prices for the 2022-2023 school year will be as follows:

Grades Preschool-5th:	\$2.60 per daily meal
Grades 6th-8th:	\$2.65 per daily meal
Grades 9th-12th:	\$2.70 per daily meal

Breakfast prices for 2022-2023 will be \$1.90 daily for Grades Preschool-12th.

School free and reduced meal guidelines and applications, and standard fee waiver forms will also be available at registration.

Student Activity tickets will be sold for \$80.00. This will cover admission to all home East Marshall varsity volleyball, football, basketball and wrestling events. Punch tickets will be sold for \$40.00 for High School events and \$20 for Middle School events. This will cover 10 admissions into all East Marshall High School or Middle School events. Senior Citizens (age 65 or older) activity tickets will be sold for \$50.00.

Students participating in any sport must carry adequate insurance coverage or have an insurance waiver signed by the parent.

Classes will begin on Tuesday, August 23, 2022, with classes being dismissed 1 hour early this day.
